HOUSE RULES & IMPORTANT INFORMATION

We would like to bring the following House Rules to your attention:

- ❖ NO LOUD MUSIC/NOISE (including fireworks, etc) aloud at any time. Noise complaints from neighbouring properties could result in a spot fine of up to R4500. Should security be called out for noise complaints, guests would be liable for the call□out fee of R150. Upon receipt of a valid noise complaint, a warning will be given by either CPF, Security companies, Owner or Caretaker. Upon receipt of a 2nd noise complaint the property must be evacuated immediately.
- NO SMOKING OR INCENSE STICKS is allowed inside the house. Non-compliance that might result in damage to furniture or property will be for the guest's account. Kindly keep the smoking to the outside.
- NO BURNING OF CANDLES is allowed inside the house. A lighted candle is an open flame, and a potential fire hazard if not carefully monitored.
- When leaving the House unoccupied and upon departure, please LOCK the door, CLOSE the windows, SWITCH OFF aircons and SET the alarm. We will not be held responsible for any loss of valuables. (If we need to switch off aircons or switch on alarms, a R150 call out fee will be deducted from the deposit.)
- Please make sure all **INSIDE** and **OUTSIDE LIGHTS** are switched off when leaving the property.
- ❖ Please take your REFUSE BAGS to the dumpsite at in Olifants street. (Located near the Marloth Shopping centre)
- NO LITTERING ALLOWED.
- ❖ Unfortunately, NO PETS ALLOWED.
- **BABOONS**: Please close all windows and doors when leaving, should baboons or monkeys enter the House, a R1000 clean-up fee will be charged.
- FIRE please do not leave any open fire unattended and please extinguish before going to bed or when leaving the premises.
- The use of the SWIMMING POOL and OUTDOOR AREA is entirely at your own risk and all under aged children must always be supervised by an adult. Water wastage due to splashing and diving as well as broken glass, food and any. Other objects left in the pool, will result in the forfeiture of the deposit.
- **❖** CAUTION OUTDOOR SURFACES ARE SLIPPERY WHEN WET
- Fiddling with the swimming pool pump is not allowed and should guests be found guilty of this; they will be liable for the cost of repair.
- ❖ CAUTION OF HOT SURFACES WHEN USING THE PIZZA BRAAI AND WOOD BURNING OVEN IN THE POOL.

- Use aircons economically, we are saving the planet


We welcome you to Shongololo Bush Villa and trust that you will enjoy your stay with us.

- ✓ PLEASE ADVISE CONTROL ROOM IF YOU'VE MADE A MISTAKE WITH THE ALARM!!!
- ❖ THE DAY OF DEPARTURE: Close all windows, make sure all the lights and aircons are switched off, close the house properly and activate the alarm again. Please use the house to such an extent as if it was your own home.

- Extra toilet paper, black bags in case the ones provided run out
